The Thomas Cole Summer Party SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS FOR 2022

We hope so much to have an in-person event this June and are working to create a magical experience that is both safe and comfortable for everyone. A few of the special accommodations that we envision are the following.

As always, the entire event will be outdoors and partially under a tent. We do not plan to close the sides of any tents, which will allow the air to flow through freely.

We plan utilize the spacious property to create a large, spread out cocktail area with multiple stations for guests to quickly and easily pick up drinks.

For the dinner portion of the evening, we are offering whole tables only and have made three table sizes available: for ten, eight or six guests.

We encourage you to contact the people with whom you are comfortable dining and share a table.

You are also welcome to seat fewer people at your table than the table can accommodate; for example, to invite just four people to the table that can fit up to six.

With conditions continually changing, we will be adjusting our plans accordingly and complying with all applicable regulations and guidelines.
